34. The Customs of the Church

It is not necessary that customs and forms of worship be exactly the same everywhere. Throughout history they have differed. They may be altered according to the differing nations, times, and habits of people provided that nothing is commanded contrary to God's Word. Whoever by his own private judgment openly, willingly, and deliberately breaks those customs and forms of worship of the church which do not contradict the Word of God and are approved by common authority, is to be openly rebuked. This is so that others will be afraid to act similarly, and in so doing offend against the common order of the church, to undermine the authority of the state's representative and to wound the consciences of weak Christians. Every particular or national church has authority to command, change, or abolish the ceremonies or forms of worship of the church which are appointed by man's authority provided that every thing is done for the building up of Christian people.

ACTIVATING POSSIBILITIES WITH (II) Spiritual Disciplines - Subduing the Flesh

Therefore, brothers and sisters, we have an obligation - but it is not to the flesh, to live according to it. For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live."

- Romans 8:12&13

The flesh has always been at war with everything that tends towards Godliness. Concisely, the term "flesh" refers to the fallen, sinful nature of humanity that is inclined towards selfishness, disobedience to God's commands, and gratification of worldly desires. In Galatians 5:19ff, Apostle Paul unravels its manifestations: "Now the works of the flesh are obvious, fornication, impurity, licentiousness (sexual immorality), idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, anger, quarrels, dissensions, factions, envy, drunkenness, carousing, and the like." In other words, the flesh is the rebellious unruly and obstinate part of our inner self. It is that part of us that does not want to be told what to do. It is stubborn, refuses correction, and hates to be under authority. It does not yield to anything other than its own wishes and desires. Flesh often desires something simply because it is forbidden. It does not want to have anything to do with God. It is intrinsically hostile to God and so yielding to the flesh is automatic enmity with God.

Apostle Paul described his experience under the influence of the flesh in Romans 7:15ff - "I do not understand what I do for what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do...For I know that good itself does not dwell in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out." This is what played out in the Garden of Eden when Eve allowed the flesh to dictate her choice. The tells: "When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it." (Genesis 3:6) Hence, the phrase "subduing the flesh" typically refers to the idea of gaining control over one's physical desires, impulses, and sinful inclinations. It is often associated with the concept of self-discipline and living a life that is pleasing to God which are the kernel of Spiritual Disciplines.

Romans 8:12-13 highlights the contrast between living according to the flesh and living by the Spirit. It encourages believers to reject the sinful tendencies of their fallen nature and, through the empowering work of the Holy Spirit, put to death the deeds of the body. By doing so, they experience true life and walk in alignment with God's purposes. We have examples in the Bible of those who subdued the flesh and came out gloriously.

In Babylon, Daniel and his companions demonstrated the spiritual discipline of subduing the flesh by rejecting the food and drink of the king and settling for only vegetables. The Bible says: "Daniel resolved not to defile himself with the royal food and wine... (Daniel 1:8) Joseph, in Egypt, disciplined himself and refused to commit sin against God even when the opportunity was available for him. At his master's wife's attempt to seduce him, "...he refused. "With me in charge," he told her, "my master does not concern himself with anything in the house; everything he owns he has entrusted to my care. No one is greater in this house than I am. My master has withheld nothing from me except you because you are his wife. How then could I do such a wicked thing and sin against God?" (Genesis 39:8&9) Our Master Jesus Christ too when tempted by the devil in Matthew 4 did not succumb to the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes and the pride of life, but vehemently refused to be swayed by the devil's persuasion.

The believer who desires to maintain a closer walk with God must be ready to yield to Paul's advice in Colossians 3:5, where he says: "Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry." Having suffered a great deal under the

burden of his sinful nature, he is in good stead to counsel rightly. He expressly announced to the Corinthians' church his struggle to subdue the flesh saying: "...I strike a blow to my body and make it my slave..." (1 Corinthians 9:27) The flesh must be subdued and kept in subjection to the will of God, if we fail to subdue the flesh, certainly and surely, the flesh will subdue us and keep us under bondage to lust, anger, and sinful desires and motive, thus pitch us against God and driving us far away from our miracles.

In conclusion, we must know that when it comes to resisting the powerful demands of our weak flesh, the Bible describes it as a kind of dying (1 Peter 2:24). That is because our deceived, corrupt flesh believes our life will be happier if we gratify it. Denying it, therefore, can feel like dying to something life-giving. However, we must remember every day that "nothing good dwells in us, that is, in our flesh" (Romans 7:18). When we, in following the Spirit's direction, die to our flesh, we are dying only to what would destroy us. So, all we are dying to is death. I think that kind of death is worth dying every day (1 Corinthians 15:31), for in such dying we choose abundant life marked by Godly possibilities for mega miracles (Deuteronomy 30:19).
