INTRODUCTION

"Then the people rejoiced, for that they offered willingly because with perfect heart they offered willingly to the Lord: and David the king also rejoiced with great joy." 1 Chronicles 29:9

Today is another epoch-making event in the annals of the history of our Cathedral as we gather to fundraise for another transformative project that will positively impact our chequered antecedents. We express profound and unreserved gratitude to God Almighty for bringing this day to pass. Our forebears laboured to bequeath us with a glorious legacy, and in our time, we too continue to make our marks and the church of God marches on illimitably. This is the promise of the Captain of our salvation Jesus Christ in Matthew 16:18 – "…I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it."

'We will build' is the theme that was impressed on my mind for this meditation. We will build, we can build and exactly that we will do. Right from biblical times, it has been the custom of God's people to build houses for Him. One such occurrence is found in the account of 1 Chronicles 29:1-9 where King David expresses his deep desire to build a house of rest for the Ark of the Covenant, which represents the presence of God. He acknowledges that while he dwells in a palace, the Ark is housed in a tent (1 Chronicles 29:2). Consequently, David pledges to personally contribute large quantities of precious materials for the construction of the temple, including gold, silver, bronze, iron, wood, onyx stones, and more (1 Chronicles 29:2-5).

This passage presents us with some lessons on the right attitude towards giving to God's cause.

- Willing Hearts: A willing heart is a heart that "wants to." When giving, it is important to do so with a willingness. Giving grudgingly or out of necessity can diminish the joy and impact of the act. It is often said that "it is better to give than to receive" because giving can bring happiness and fulfilment to both the giver and the recipient. The Bible says: "Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." (2Corinthians 9:7)
- Wholehearted Giving: In the Bible, it is mentioned that David gave to God freely and wholeheartedly. Jesus in Mark 12:30 admonishes us: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength." This verse underscores the importance of loving God with every aspect of your being, which includes giving to Him with your whole heart.

Inspiring Others: David's commitment to the temple inspires the leaders and people of Israel to give willingly and generously. They offer their own treasures and resources for the building of the Lord's house (1 Chronicles 29:6-9). Our acts of generosity can inspire others to join us in joyfully serving the Lord and building His kingdom.

Rejoicing in God's Presence: This results from the understanding that it is a privilege to be counted worthy to give towards Godly causes. David finds great joy in the presence of our loving God, who blesses us abundantly and calls us to participate in His work. He expressed his gratitude and joy to God saying: "But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand. (1 Chronicles 29:14)

Unity and Collaboration: The passage also highlights the collaborative efforts of the people of Israel. They willingly offer their resources and talents, working together for a common purpose. This emphasis on unity and collaboration reflects a broader theological belief that God's people should work together in harmony to accomplish His purposes. God recognises this in Genesis 11:6 – "The LORD said, "If as one people speaking the same language, they have begun to do this, then nothing they plan to do will

be impossible for them." The exploit at the Tower of Babel resulted from the collaborative effort of the people.
