# BIBLE STUDY OUTLINE

**THEME:** IN THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST

**SUB-THEME:** Attributes of Jesus Christ (11)

**TOPIC:** Omnipotence

**TEXTS:** *Genesis 1: 1-3; John 1: 1-4; Matthew 28: 18.*

**AIMS:**

- i. *To learn that Jesus share the same all powerful nature with God and*
- ii. *To shows Jesus' empowerment of His followers.*

**INTRODUCTION:**

"Omnipotence" is a theological term that refers to the all-encompassing power of God. It describes God as having virtually unlimited authority or influence. From Genesis to Revelation, the Bible reveals Jesus Christ as sharing omnipotence with God. Our study shall further expose the universal omnipotence of our Lord Jesus Christ.

He reveals in the Bible that He is all-powerful and in the final sense is the ruler of nature, history and nations as nations are as a drop in a bucket and counted as small dust on the balance (*Isa. 40: 15*). He is the all-powerful Lord who has created all things and sustains them by the Word of His power (*Gen. 1:1-3; Heb. 1: 3*). Yet He has so fashioned human beings that He graciously appeals to them to return to Him in obedience because He holds them responsible for their thoughts and actions.

**STUDY GUIDE/QUESTIONS:**

1. Describe the oneness of God's omnipotence with Jesus Christ in *John 1:1-4; Phil 2:9-11; Heb 1:3*; compare *Gen 1:3; Psalm 3:6*.
2. What are some of the different situations in which Jesus demonstrated His omnipotence in His earthly ministry? *Acts 10: 38; John 2: 7-9; Mark 5:1-13; Luke 8:43-44*
3. How has Jesus empowered His disciples and the Christians in our generation for the continuation of His ministry? *Luke 9: 1-2; Matt 28;18; Mark 16:17-18; Acts 1: 8; 19:13-17.*
4. What can possibly limit the operations of Christ' omnipotence in our Christian lives? *Isa. 59: 1-2; Matt. 13:58; 17: 14-20.*

**CONCLUSION:** The omnipotence of Jesus Christ was totally manifested in His conquering of death in order to open the gate of salvation to all who believe in Him. The climax of His omnipotence is in judging the whole world; both great and small.

**FOOD FOR THOUGHT:** No one can be more powerful than Jesus Christ the conqueror of death.

## **SOUL FOOD 28/2020**

**“REMEMBER THE LORD YOUR GOD...”**

*- Deut. 8:18*

***“You shall remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you power to get wealth, that he may confirm his covenant that he swore to your fathers, as it is this day.”***

*- Deuteronomy 8:18*

Why Harvest this year? Are you still going on with the Harvest as planned? For obvious reasons these are questions that have been asked repeatedly about Harvest Celebrations 2020 which we are launching today, and my answers to them have remained in the affirmative, that in as much as we continue to be recipients of God’s goodness, we cannot but thank Him as a Church. No matter the circumstances, it is God’s will for us to give Him thanks always. 1Thess 5:18 says: “Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God’s will for you who belong to Christ Jesus.” God says: “As long as the earth remains, ... seedtime and harvest time, ... will not cease.” (Genesis 8:22). “Because of the Lord’s great love, we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail.” (Lamentations 3:22). And so, we thank God for bringing us to the start of our Harvest Celebrations for 2020. May He countenance our worship and offerings and bless us more in Jesus name.

The theme for this year’s Harvest Season is: “Remember the Lord your God” taken from Deuteronomy 8:18 which reads: “You shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may confirm His covenant that He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.” This theme is the Lord’s command to the Israelites just before they entered the Promised Land, He commands them to remember Him as the Source of everything they possess and would later acquire. God the Creator, and the Owner of the world does not want to be forgotten or relegated to the background, He desires prime consideration in all situations as the Almighty Decider of all things.

Stating the obvious, the tendency to forget facts or events over time especially those pertaining to God is more common among us than we might care to admit. It is a sin that wears several disguises. We are easily carried away by circumstances and we find it so easy to forget God, particularly in an individualist and independent culture like ours in which reigns the attitude of “I am my own boss,” “I am the captain of my soul,” “I am in control of my life,” etc.

But why do we forget God easily? We forget God when we worry and allow fear to take over. When we take His physical absence to mean non-existence or abandonment, we worry and forget that God is Sovereign and that He is in control and His promises are faithful and sure. “Be anxious for nothing but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.” (Philippians 4:6). We also forget God when we allow Pride to take over our life, we become puffed up with pride and arrogance and then attribute our accomplishments to our own hard work and forget that God was the one who gave the ability to acquire all we have. The account of the Rich Fool in Luke 12:13-21 describes this better.

In our tradition Harvest celebration is one of the many avenues through which we remember God and give Him thanks for all that He has done for us. Not celebrating this harvest will amount to forgetting God. He commands in Deuteronomy 16:16 thus: "Each year every man in Israel must celebrate these three festivals: The Festival of Unleavened Bread, the Festival of Harvest, and the Festival of Shelters. On each of these occasions, all men must appear before the LORD your God at the place He chooses, but they must not appear before the LORD without a gift for Him." (NLT)

We should remember God - whether in the valley of tragedy or on the mountain of triumph. He is our Keeper and Provider. Whatever is happening around us, He deserves our recognition. Rev. Johnson Oatman, Jr. encourages us in his evergreen composition - "When upon life's billows you are tempest tossed" - to constantly remember the Lord by counting our blessing and naming them one by one. He asserts that we will be surprised at what the Lord has done for us. Let us therefore look beyond the uncertainties and gloomy ambience around us to remember the Lord our God. Let us thank Him for His mercies and lovingkindness toward us with the fruits of our lips and the substances He has blessed us with.

Thus, says the Lord: "Encourage My children to donate toward the success of this year's harvest. I have some extraordinary blessings for those who will obey this instruction." He who has ears let him hear what the Spirit says to the Church.
