Bible Study Outline

THEME: THE LORD GOD AND THE REIGN OF PEACE

SUB THEME: Mandate of God to Earthly Leaders - 2

TOPIC: Justice

TEXT: Deut. 16:18-22

AIMS:

- i. to discuss the biblical injunction on righteous justice and*
- ii. to examine how faithful our earthly leaders are in delivering justice according to God's mandate.*

INTRODUCTION

Today is another significant day in the Church calendar, the Rogation Sunday, a day set aside to ask or plead for God's mercy. It is important to note that the God of mercy is equally the God of justice and that He requires justice from us in all our deeds. Our text today clearly shows God's mandate to leaders in delivering justice to their people.

How faithful are contemporary leaders to this mandate? Let us discuss this through our Study Guide.

STUDY GUIDE

1. From the Bible passage today (Deut. 16:18-22), what are the mandates of God to judges? Compare Lev 19:15
2. Compare Pro. 29:2 with 1 Kings 10:8, Gen 18:19 and expatiate on the benefits of righteous justice in the society.
3. Critically examine some of the actions of our contemporary leaders and evaluate how faithful they are on issues relating to social justice.
4. Amos 5:24 says, **"But let judgment run down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream."** Discuss how Christians can influence the society by their words (preaching) and deeds.

CONCLUSION

Justice is not a mere responsibility for our leaders, it is a mandate of God to them for their reign to usher in peace, joy and progress to the people they serve. Adhering to this will justify their reign as serving God and humanity.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT: While Justice brings Joy, Injustice brings sorrow.

The Anglican Communion consists of autonomous national churches that are bound together by intangible links best described as ties of loyalty between the see of Canterbury and each other. The basic unit of the Anglican Communion is the diocese, a geographic area over which a bishop presides. Dioceses generally form part of a larger unit known as a province, but even these are far from uniform in configuration. A province may, for example, be part of an autonomous church: the Church of Nigeria Anglican Communion is the largest Anglican province on the continent of Africa, accounting for 41.7% of Anglicans in Sub-Saharan Africa, and is probably the largest within the Anglican Communion in terms of active members. Since 2002 the Church of Nigeria has been organised into 14 ecclesiastical Provinces. The administrative headquarters are in Abuja. Its Primate, Archbishop and Metropolitan is The Most Rev. Dr. Henry Chukwudum Ndukuba.

SOUL FOOD 21/2022 PRAY YOUR WAY TO SATISFACTION

"And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldst bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldst keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested." - 1 Chronicles 4:10

One of the greatest gifts that God gave us is the gift of prayer. God looked at the way He can communicate with His children effectively, then He established the power of prayer. Prayer is an opportunity to spend time with God. To really change your level, you need to pray. However, if you really want to overcome your enemies, you need prayers (Eph 6:12)

Prayer is the weapon of every Christian. It is the instrument used to proclaim God's blessings and to fight the enemies.

It brings deliverance, transformation, victory and testimony. Many people did not have a prayer lifestyle. And those who do not pay much interest in prayers ends up as preys to the enemy.

The Prayer of Jabez reveals that Jabez understands what many people do not - there is only one God and He should be the centre of our work God wants to bless every life. But, we must first make the choice to invite God into our life and ask for His blessings. Jabez wants to succeed and increase his sphere of influence for God. The specific sphere of influence is not important. What is important is that when we want to reach for goals and accomplishments that we have God on our side. Proverbs 16:3 says, "Commit thy works unto the LORD, and thy thoughts shall be established." It is critical to understand and practice this in a close relationship with God. Further, it is equally important to stay close to God and rely on His continued support and guidance throughout life. Jabez clearly knows and prays specifically to the One who can protect him from evil and pain -- God. At the end of the verse it is clear that God approved of this faithful prayer by granting it. It is also important to see that Jabez was passionate in his plea to God: "He cried out to the God of Israel." God wants to hear that we need Him through passionate prayer.

The Prayer of Jabez reminds us that everybody struggles with choosing to rely on himself or God. Whether you are a focused Christian or just searching to find out more about God, life is a growing process. However, it is very clear in reviewing the Prayer of Jabez, as well as the rest of the Bible, that God is faithful in caring for those who seek Him. He remain faithful to His words concerning bringing us divine satisfaction, Jabez sets a great example of how God wants everyone to come to Him through constant and passionate prayer. If you are looking to start a relationship with God or improve your existing relationship with Him, or you truly desire divine satisfaction, start with prayer. God answers prayers when you trust Him (1 Chronicles 5:20). Prayers to God also please Him (Proverbs 15:8). We can all learn from Jabez and faithfully pray to God always in everything that we do.

Now, what is the outcome for this dimension of prayer where we access our inheritance in God?

1. **A life of fulfillment and satisfaction.**
One outcome of accessing our inheritance in God is a life of fulfillment and satisfaction; a life devoid of the distraction of lack. So, when we come to the altar of prayer to access our inheritance in God, we are positioned for fulfillment and satisfaction in life (Joel 2:26).
2. **The life of focused spirituality.**
Our spirituality is focused when we access our inheritance in God. The Scripture says that you shall eat in plenty and praise the Lord (Joel 2:26). You see, nothing distracts spirituality like scarcity; nothing attacks spirituality like poverty. Poverty is a distraction of spirituality; scarcity is a distraction of intimacy with God. The mind you should have used to meditate on Scriptures is now used to calculate the challenges of house rent, children's school fees, food to eat, etc. There are people who sit in church and their mind is not on the message being preached because they are wondering what to eat after service. Today, I decree the expiration of the days of scarcity and shortage in your life in Jesus' Name.
3. **The life of impact both on humanity and eternity (1 Kings 9:10-11)**
You will be able to touch lives positively when you access your inheritance in God. When you access your inheritance in God, you can build a church, wipe out scarcity from families and employ thousands of people, etc. because you have the means to do so (1 Kings 9:10-11). This is why we do more good with money than without money. So, when some people, out of poverty of understanding, say that the church should not preach to people about money, what they mean is that people should be left to die in poverty and wretchedness. God forbid!

Beloved, make up your mind to access your inheritance in God so you can live a life of maximum impact on earth.
