# Bible Study Outline

TEXT: Phil 2:5-13

## INTRODUCTION

Last Thursday, May 9 marked the 40th day after the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ and it is remembered as the day he ascended into heaven (Acts 1:9). Today, being the Sunday after, our study shall be centred on being lifted up by God. In this study, we want to see being lifted up by God to mean He steps in and changes our position or status for the best.

## STUDY GUIDES

1. What does lifting up and being lifted up in the context of Matt 4:5-6, Acts 1:9 and Phil 2:9 mean?
2. From Phil 2:6-8, critically analyse the qualities that led to the uplifting up of Jesus Christ by God. How can these qualities help in lifting us up as Christians?
3. Is there anything like satanic lifting? Critically discuss this in the context of Matt 4:5-6. Describe how some people were uplifted in our generation in the context of Num 16:1-3, 32-35.
4. Discuss the Biblical injunctions for God's uplifting according to Gen 41:38-40; Matt 23:12; James 4:10.

**CONCLUSION:** There is no doubt that every good purpose of God has its satanic versions, including promotion. We should be very careful to know when Satan is approaching us to improve our lives, which invariably will end in degradation (Luke 14:11). As Christians, we should always desire the virtues for humility and godliness so as to be uplifted at God's own time.

**ARTICLE XX**

**20. The Authority of the Church**

The church has authority to decree forms of worship and ceremonies and to decide in controversies concerning the faith. However, it is not lawful for the church to order anything contrary to God's written Word. Nor may it expound one passage of Scripture so that it contradicts another passage. So, although the church is a witness and guardian to Holy Scripture, it must not decree anything contrary to Scripture, nor is it to enforce belief in anything additional to Scripture as essential to salvation.

## **SOUL FOOD 19/2024**

### **ASCENDED ALSO FOR OUR FULL RESTORATION**

***“Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.”***  
**- Romans 8:34**

The Ascension, a pivotal moment in Jesus Christ’s mission, marked a significant milestone in His ministry. It was not just a mere event but a crucial part of His earthly mission to revive our relationship with God and bridge the gap between us and Him. From His birth to His last moments on earth, He dedicated Himself diligently to this cause. Acts of the Apostles 1 vividly describes how He was taken up into the heavens in the presence of His disciples (Acts 1:9-10).

Ascension of Christ holds profound spiritual significance. It marks the completion of Jesus’ earthly mission and the beginning of His eternal reign. It cannot, therefore, be trivialised or wished away. Paul boldly argues: “Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died - more than that, who was raised to life - is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.” (Romans 8:34) Paul emphasises that there is no one who can successfully bring a charge or condemnation against those whom God has justified, because of all Christ had done to redeem humankind especially His exaltation by His ascension to a position of honour, authority and power at God’s right hand.

Accordingly, our reference text concludes with the comforting assurance that the ascended Christ is not just a distant figure but an active Intercessor for believers. Jesus, as God and the one who experienced human life and trials, continuously advocates and prays for believers before the Father. This ongoing role ensures security and spiritual support for believers. It provides us with a sense of security and reassurance in our faith. Hence, we boldly announce in the theme that Christ’s ascension also favours our complete restoration.

Jesus Christ fulfilled humanity’s innate longing for divine justice and mercy and provided a mediator to bridge the gap between human suffering and divine providence. As our Friend, He intercedes for us before His Father and represents us in the Council of Yahweh, where important divine decisions are made. With Jesus as our advocate, we can trust that we will not be excluded from the eternal reckoning and that our needs and desires will be adequately represented.

Job, in his travail, acknowledged an advocate who is on high in his reply to his friends, saying: “Even now my witness is in heaven; my advocate is on high. My intercessor is my friend as my eyes pour out tears to God; on behalf of a man, he pleads with God as one pleads for a friend.” (Job 16:19-21) Job refers to his “intercessor” as his friend, indicating a close, personal relationship with the divine advocate. The use of

“friend” here emphasises the intercessor’s empathy and understanding of Job’s plight. As Job weeps (“my eyes pour out tears to God”), he finds solace in knowing that he has a heavenly intercessor who is sympathetic to his suffering and actively pleading on his behalf.

Against this backdrop, the writer to the Hebrews in Chapter 4:14-16 would invite us to make the most of the privilege of having an Advocate in heaven, saying: “Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities... Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.”

This year’s Ascensiontide calls us to foster a personal and intimate relationship with our Advocate, who is in Heaven, Jesus Christ, to have the complete restoration promised by God. Knowing He would be there at God’s right hand, He prepared His disciples to use this privilege well. He says: ‘In that day you will no longer ask me anything. Very truly I tell you, my Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. Until now, you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask, and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.’ (John 16:23&24) Jesus Christ has restored our ability to have a direct, personal relationship with God, characterised by open communication through prayer and complete joy - critical aspects of the life intended for humanity before the fall.

We now have a new kind of access to God the Father - access mediated through Jesus’ name. I urge you to make the most of this privilege.
