Bible Study Outline

THEME: THE CHRISTIAN RACE

SUB-THEME: Trinity Sunday

TOPIC: Unity in the Race

TEXT: Acts 4:23-34

AIMS:

- i. to teach the unity in Christendom as an antidote of satanic invasion and
- ii. to discuss how we can be united effectively even in diversity.

INTRODUCTION

We thank God for another Trinity Sunday; a Sunday that reminds us of the unity of God the father, God the

Son and God the Holy Spirit as one God in three and not three gods in one. The Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ brings believers together in the unity of faith with God the father, our maker; Jesus Christ our Saviour, (God the son) and the Holy Spirit, the Sanctifier of the Church. Biblical passages reveal the three in one God as one. The early Church operated in this Trinitarian power, which brought about her firm establishment. We can see the power of oppression against the Apostles in action in our text today, but the Church united against this her enemy and conquered the gate of hell.

STUDY GUIDES

1. How can you explain the term Trinity in the context of Gen 1:1-3, 26; Luke 1:35 and Matt 3:16-17?
2. How can you describe the unity of the early Church in our study today? See Acts 4:32; 5:12;
3. Satan attacks the church of Christ today, both physically and spiritually. How can the unity of believers destroy these invasions? Compare Acts 4:15-19, 23 and 31 with Acts 12:5-9.
4. How can we strengthen the unity of the Church even in our diversity? Gal 3:26-28; 2Tim 2:23-25

CONCLUSION: Despite denominational disparity, and doctrinal divergences our priority in preaching the gospel should be focused on winning souls into God's kingdom. In doing this, the kingdom of Satan will always be depopulated.

ARTICLE XXI

21. The Authority of General Councils

[The Twenty-first of the former Articles is omitted; because it is partly of a local and civil nature, and is provided for, as to the remaining parts of it, in other Articles] The original 1571, 1662 text of this Article, omitted in the version of 1801, reads as follows: "General Councils may not be gathered together without the commandment and will of princes. 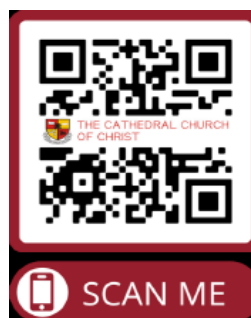
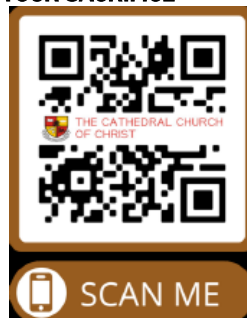

SOUL FOOD 21/2024

THE TRIUNE GOD:

WORKING FOR THE FULL RESTORATION OF HUMANITY

“Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me, or at least believe on the evidence of the works themselves... If you love me, keep my commands. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever – the Spirit of Truth.” -John 14:11,15-17

The Doctrine of the Trinity, which we commemorate today, remains a profound and awe-inspiring mystery. It describes God as one being in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, with each person being equal to the others and eternal. No one person precedes the others in time or nature. For this awesomeness, this doctrine has been and continues to be a subject of theological discussion, exploration, and reflection, enriching believers’ understanding of God’s nature and connection with Him. From Scripture, we see that this Triune God - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - works in a divine and perfect collaboration, a sublime unity, for the ultimate purpose of restoring humanity to its original dignity and harmony with God.

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth (Genesis 1:1). Everything that exists does so by the will and word of the Father. But beyond creation, from the moment sin entered the world, the Father’s heart has been set on redemption, so He promised restoration and salvation (Genesis 3:15). This promise was not merely a reaction to sin but a revelation of His love and mercy that transcends human understanding. The apostle Paul speaks to the Ephesians about God’s overarching plan, “He made known to us the mystery of His will according to His good pleasure, which He purposed in Christ, to be put into effect when the times reach their fulfilment—to bring unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ” (Ephesians 1:9-10). God, the Father, initiates salvation, orchestrating the grand narrative of restoration.

In this divine plan, we find God, the Son - Jesus Christ, as the central figure. Born into our world, He bridges the vast chasm sin created between God and humanity. John’s Gospel declares, “For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life” (John 3:16). In Jesus’ own words, we discover His mission which is redemption. He says: “The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many” (Mark 10:45). Through His incarnation, teaching, death, and resurrection, Jesus reconciles humanity to God. His sacrifice atoned for the sins of all people, restoring the broken relationship between God and humankind and offering the hope of eternal life. In addition, God, the Son, exemplifies the perfect human life, serving as a model for believers to emulate.

After Jesus ascended, He and the Father sent the Holy Spirit at Pentecost to indwell and empower believers. The Holy Spirit is the breath of God’s life in us. He convicts, comforts, guides, and empowers. Jesus told His disciples, “But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you” (John 14:26). Moreover, the Spirit’s work in us is transformative, changing us from the inside out so that we can live as new creations (2 Corinthians 5:17). This ongoing process of sanctification is vital for our restoration, as Paul writes, “And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord’s glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit” (2 Corinthians 3:18).

As many opine, the doctrine of the Trinity is not merely a theological puzzle to solve but a revelation of God’s nature and His approach to our salvation. Together, the Trinity embodies the fullness of God’s approach to restoring humanity. This is about redemption from sin and its consequences, transforming the human heart and mind, and

enabling a life that reflects divine love and holiness. The Trinity, therefore, is a complex and dynamic relationship of love, inviting humanity into God's eternal life. Through this framework, as believers, we are encouraged to participate in the divine nature by faith, progressively restored into the image of Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit within the loving sovereignty of the Father.

We are urged in the *Quicumque Vult* (commonly called the Creed of Saint Athanasius) to embrace faith in the Godhead to enjoy all that He has to offer; the opening paragraph reads:

Whosoever will be saved: before all things, it is necessary that he hold the Catholic Faith. Which Faith except everyone do keep whole and undefiled: without doubt, he shall perish everlastingly. And the Catholic Faith is this: That we worship one God in Trinity, and Trinity in Unity; Neither confounding the Persons: nor dividing the Substance. For there is one Person of the Father, another of the Son: and another of the Holy Ghost. But the Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost, is all one: the Glory equal, the Majesty co-eternal.

Also, the great Puritan theologian John Owen once wrote:

There was no more glorious mystery brought to light in and by Jesus Christ than that of the holy Trinity, or the subsistence of the three persons in the unity of the same divine nature...And this revelation is made unto us, not that our minds might be possessed with the notions of it, but that we may know aright how to place our trust in him, how to obey him and live unto him, how to obtain and exercise communion with him, until we come to the enjoyment of him.

In other words, the doctrine of the Trinity is the foundation of all our communion with God and comfortable dependence upon Him. To know God, to have fellowship with Him, to commune with Him, and to enjoy His offer of salvation is to converse with the three members of the Godhead in their proper order and role.

As we meditate once again on the Trinity today, let us approach God with faith, relying on the Father's plan, the Son's sacrifice, and the transforming power of the spirit. Let us celebrate their unified effort for our restoration and the ultimate renewal of all creation.
