Bible Study Outline

THEME: THE CHRISTIAN RACE

SUB-THEME: Equipped for the Race 1

TOPIC: Spiritual Nourishment

TEXT: Eze.3:1-14

AIMS:

- i. to define spiritual nourishment and the sources,
- ii. to study the spiritual food for spiritual nourishment and
- iii. the spiritual food that can destroy the souls.

INTRODUCTION

We say happy celebrations to all fathers in Christendom. May the Lord continue to grant you the grace to give godly leadership to your families in Jesus name. As one needs food that gives energy; enhances growth and development in any journey, so is the need for spiritual nourishment for the renewal of our minds and for growth in Christian faith. Our Bible passage reveals how Prophet Ezekiel was fed with the word of God (Vs 1-2). Initially, it was sweet for the belly (Vs 3), but later it became bitter (Vs 14). Nevertheless, because of the nutrients derived from the food (Word of God) he was strengthened for the journey.

STUDY GUIDES

1. How do you understand Spiritual nourishment? Compare Eze 3:1-3 with Jer 5:16. In addition, how can a father nourish his family spiritually? Gen 18:19; 6:6-7; Jos 24:15; Eph 6:4.
2. It is easy to preach the gospel than to do, or act the gospel. Discuss this in the light of Rev 10:9-10 and Matt 23:1-3.
3. Analyse the sources of spiritual nourishment in these texts John 6:51; 1Tim.4:13-16; 1Peter 2:2.
4. Are there spiritual malnourishments or poison in our heavenly race? If there are, what are the possible consequences? ; Jer. 23:16; Mic 3:5; Mt 24:4-5, 11, 24.

CONCLUSION: As Christians, we need the word of God that speaks of Christ and leads us to Him, whether it is written in the scriptures, spoken by latter-day prophets, or taught by other humble servants of God.

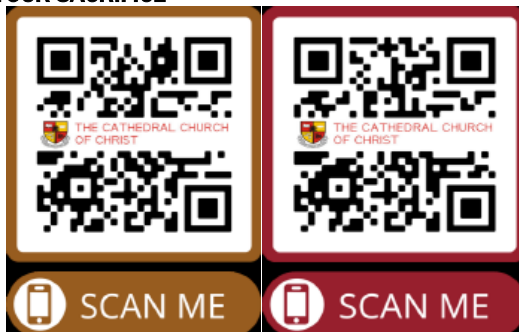

RESTORING GODLY VALUES AT HOME:

The Father's Role

"And you fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord"
- Ephesians 6:4

The perilous times Apostle Paul referred to in his letter to Timothy are upon us. Paul said, *"In the last days, perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of themselves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, without natural affection, truce-breakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, high-minded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof"* (2 Timothy 3:1-5). Prophet Micah also foretold these times, describing a season when sons will dishonour their fathers, daughters will rise against their mothers, and a man's enemies will be the members of his household (Micah 7:6).

We are undoubtedly in these troubling times, and the church, which should be the light and salt of the world (Matthew 5:13-14), is not exempt from today's moral decay. Leonard Ravenhill, in his book *"Why Revival Tarries,"* observed, *"The church began with men in the upper room agonising; today, it is ending with men in the supper room organising. The church began in revival; we are ending in ritual. We started virile; we are ending sterile. Chartered members of the Church were men of heat and no degrees; today, many hold degrees but have no heat."*

Our world is on a downward slope regarding ethics, morals, values, humanity, and dignity. Modern society revels in bad behaviours, celebrates immoralities, upholds indecent dressings, reveres nudity, and showcases unimaginable family dysfunction, disrespect for elders and authorities, greed, drunkenness, wickedness, lack of integrity, and pride.

The good news, however, is that all hope is not lost. God promises restoration for the fading virtues of honour to parents, love, respect, honesty, forgiveness, service, gratitude, integrity, contentment, faith, humility, and mutual respect. Job 14:7-8 says, *"... there is hope of a tree, if it be cut down, that it will sprout again, and that the tender branch thereof will not cease. Though the root thereof wax old in the earth, and the stock thereof die in the ground."* With God, the dead and dying bones can rise again, and the lost godly values shall be restored in the name of Jesus.

Against this backdrop, God has placed high expectations on fathers as the link to restoring homes to the path of right values. In God's established order, fathers are highly placed to oversee and guide their homes in righteousness. A father is the head of his wife as Christ is the head of the church (1 Corinthians 11:3; Ephesians 5:23), the ambassador of the family (1 Timothy 2:12), has a duty of provision for the home (1 Timothy 5:8), is in charge of managing the family's affairs (1 Timothy 3:5, 12), and is the architect of discipline and right conduct (Ephesians 6:4).

Apostle Paul, in our text, highlighted the benefits of prosperity and longevity available to homes that honour parents (Ephesians 6:1-2). He emphasised the obligation of fathers towards creating a good home and, by extension, a decent society. Fathers must promote godly ideals and uphold godly values through love (Ephesians 4:2-3), humility (Philippians 2:5), faith in God (Hebrews 11:6), wisdom (James 1:5), kindness (Ephesians 4:32), gratitude (1 Thessalonians 5:18), forgiveness (Colossians 3:13), service to God and humanity (Philippians 2:3-4), and contentment. When family members showcase godly character and right conduct, it reflects the father's adherence to biblical dictates and discipline.

Eli and his sons, Hophni and Phinehas, lost their lives and heritage due to Eli's deficiency in family discipline and prioritising his children over God (1 Samuel 2:12-36).

Nation-building begins with the family unit, and this change lies at the doorstep of fathers. A disciplined father will lead to a good home and, consequently, a better society. Today's Father's Day celebration is an opportunity to encourage fathers to step up in their roles at home. Fathers should demonstrate good examples, apt leadership, credible mentorship, proper discipline, and spiritual navigation. A home aligned with good values results from the father's instillation of these values.

I pray for fathers today that your homes will model Christ. May your children give you peace in your twilight years and make you stand tall before God at the end of your journey. When the trumpet sounds and you stand before God to give an account of your fatherly role, may it be said that you came, saw, and conquered in the name of Jesus Christ.
